We are looking forward to your arrival at Coconut Cove Resort. Please **verify** that the dates of your camping stay are accurate. Notify the office **immediately** if you have upgraded your camping unit or increased the number of people camping with you. We do have free Wi-Fi Hot spot available at the Clubhouse. For insurance reasons, we do not allow overnight campers to bring in their personal golf cart, unless arrangements were made when making your reservation.

Coconut Cove Resort believes safety and enjoyment are important priorities in our campground, therefore we ask that you observe our Rules and Signs posted throughout the campground. Please notify us of any situation that may require our attention.

Resort Check In—2 PM. We encourage campers to arrive at the resort by no later than 8 PM. Earlier is better. Please be courteous to other campers by not arriving late into the night.

Resort Check Out—No later than 11 AM.

Clubhouse / Restaurant—High Season: Mon, Wed-Sun, 11 AM – Close. Tuesdays – Closed.

Clubhouse Office / Resort Store Hours—

High Season: Mon-Thur, 9 AM-6 PM; Fri- Sat, 9 AM-7 PM; Sun, 9 AM-6 PM.

Low Season: Hours vary, contact Clubhouse.

We offer coffee, ice cream, slushies, candy, small toys, Coconut Cove apparel and accessories, pharmacy items, ice, firewood, to-go beer, camping supplies, cigarettes and more!

Quiet Hours—11 PM – 8 AM. Quiet time means **NO** loud music, loud conversation, or excessive noise. During Quiet Hours golf carts should be used only for direct travel to a specific destination, not for joy riding. Any drunkenness, profanity or other disruptive behavior will **not** be tolerated and may result in immediate ejection from the campground without refund.

Campsite Definition—One camper unit and one tow vehicle are allowed per site. A fee of \$5 per stay will be charged for each additional vehicle. Overnight Camping/Glamping Pod site prices include a maximum family size of 4 and Cabin site prices include a maximum family size of 5. Each site includes water, 30/50-amp electric, sewer, a picnic table and a fire pit. Overnight Camping/Glamping Pod wristbands are included up to 4 persons and Cabin wristbands are included up to 5 persons of your group for access to beach/lake/pool. Aqua park is an extra charge.

Additional Family Members/Guests – If your group consists of more than 4 persons (Overnight Camping/Glamping Pod) or 5 persons (Cabin), each additional person who plans to use the recreational amenities must buy a day pass at the posted rates and will be issued a wristband. Weekend Overnight Campers wristband \$25 per person. Please make these arrangements at the Clubhouse when checking in.

Visitors—All visitors must register at the office before entering the campground. Visitors to campsites will be charged a parking fee of \$5 per day. Visitors who use the recreational amenities must buy a day pass and will be issued a wristband; they do not need to pay parking.

Carry-In Beer/Coolers/Liquor—We do not allow carry-in beer, liquor or coolers at the pool or beach. Service is available at our Poolside & Beachside Tiki Bars and Resort Store.

Campers/Children/Guests—Curfew for children to be at their campsite is 9:00 PM. Minors are not allowed to smoke/drink alcohol anywhere on the property. Be sure that all children know the number of their campsite in case of separation.

Swimming Pools/Lake—Open Late May -Early September (weather permitting), 7 days a week from 10 AM-8 PM. **There is no lifeguard on duty. Swimming is at your own risk and children under 14 years old must be accompanied by a parent.** Appropriate swimwear must be worn including swim diapers, which can be purchased at Resort Store. **No glass allowed!**

Aqua Park—Open Memorial Day – Labor Day, 12 PM-5 PM, daily (weather permitting). Overnight campers receive a discount on the [Aqua Park](#); \$10 Weekday / \$15 Weekend for the full day. Life Jackets are required for all ages (and available while supplies last). Must be at least 7 years old. Anyone under 14 must be accompanied by someone at least 16 years old. Aqua Park is closed weekdays beginning August 23.

Cabins/Pods— Must be 25 years old to rent a Cabin or Pod. No Pets/No Smoking. Please bring your own bed/bath linens. Cabins have 1 queen, 1 double, 1 single and 1 futon couch. Pods have 1 full bed and 1 futon couch. Many campers bring sleeping bags rather than bed linens. We include toilet paper, garbage bags and hand soap. We also, suggest necessary paper good, paper towels, extra garbage bags and a few DVDs (no cable). Please leave the unit picked up and “broom clean”. A minimum \$50 charge will be assessed for units that are damaged, left cluttered with garbage or very unclean.

Pets—Limited to 2 pets. All pets must be on a leash, not left unattended and picked up after. Pets must be quiet. Upon your departure, the site should be clean and ready for the next camper who may not have a pet. Pets are **not** allowed in our cabins, pods, campground activity areas or in any common buildings.

Dog Park—Open 10 AM – 8 PM and for Seasonal and Overnight Campers use **ONLY**. No Pets left unattended while using the Dog Park. All Pet feces must be cleaned up immediately by the owner and properly disposed of. Pets must be quiet and non-aggressive.

Firewood—We sell firewood and can be purchased when our registration representative calls to pre-check you in. We will pre-deliver, so it is at your site when you arrive. **Incoming firewood is strictly prohibited and will be cause for immediate eviction.**

Campfires—Fires may be built only in the firepit provided with the site. Be sure to extinguish fires before leaving the campsite. The Resort Store sells firewood, fire starter, marshmallows, graham crackers, Hersey bars, roasting forks and more to enjoy the campfire FUN!

Garbage—All garbage is to be placed in garbage bags and put in the dumpsters near the exit.

Golf Carts – We have golf carts available for rent and can be reserved when our registration representative calls to pre-check you in. Only those with a valid driver’s license are allowed to drive golf carts on the property. This will be strictly enforced.

ATV/UTV’s—Coconut Cove is ATV/UTV friendly! In fact, it is legal to operate your ATV/UTV on the county road system in Wisconsin. We only ask ATV/UTV riders observe our 5-mph speed limit in the park and use it to go from point A to point B. Please no joy riding throughout park. Also, ATV/UTV’s are noisier than golf cart and we therefore don’t allow their use after 8 PM. You must be 18 years old to operate ATV/UTV on resort property.

Fireworks—Not allowed on the property at any time, even on holidays.
